RESOLUTION DENYING THE REQUEST OF CONCERNED BLUTODA PRESIDENTS FOR POSTPONEMENT OF THE MANDATORY IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PRESCRIBED TRICYCLE BODY COLOR IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURGOS, LA UNION

WHEREAS, received by this Office on January 5, 2026 is a letter request from concerned BLUTODA Presidents requesting for postponement of the mandatory implementation of the prescribed tricycle body color (Golden Yellow) in the Municipality of Burgos, La Union;

WHEREAS, upon review of the said letter, the Sangguniang Bayan unanimously agree to **DENY** the said request due to the following reasons:

1. Section 26, Article G of Municipal Ordinance No. 127-2024 recently approved last December 2, 2024 states that:

"Section 26. Color Scheme Assignment. The prescribed color for every MTH operating within the municipality shall be GOLDEN YELLOW and shall be painted all over the sidecar of the tricycle"

2. The approved ordinance was consulted to the public on November 14, 2024 where a number of BLUTODA members attended and the color scheme Golden Yellow was approved; and:

3. Based on records in this Office, during the application for franchise renewal last January 1-20, 2025, utmost consideration was given to concerned operators/drivers to improve their tricycle body color and agreed with the condition of the Municipal Treasurer (concerned operators/drivers signed to the agreement), xerox copies of this agreements are hereto attached.



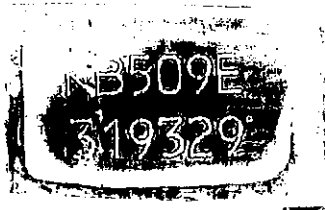

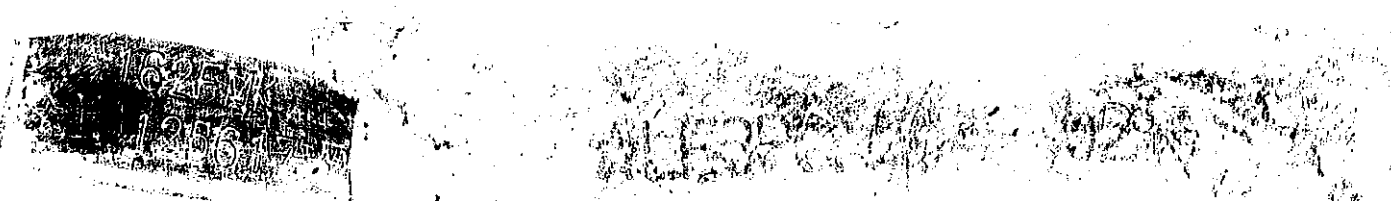

However, we respectfully seek your compassion and understanding regarding the **present financial condition of many tricycle operators and drivers**.


Currently, a significant number of operators are facing serious economic challenges. Daily earnings are barely sufficient to meet basic household needs such as food, utilities, education, and medical expenses. The added cost of repainting or modifying tricycles to comply with the required body color would place a **heavy and immediate financial burden**, which many are currently unable to afford without incurring debt or sacrificing essential family needs.


Considering these circumstances, we sincerely appeal for a **temporary deferment or postponement of the implementation**. Allowing additional time would greatly ease the burden on affected operators and enable them to better prepare financially, while still supporting the municipality's long-term plans. We firmly believe that policies implemented with compassion and proper timing foster stronger cooperation and compliance from the community.

We respectfully assure your office of our willingness to cooperate fully with the local government once conditions improve or when reasonable assistance, incentives, or alternative arrangement may be considered.


