BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO.1-2026

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF STRAY ANIMALS IN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE BARANGAY OF DELLES, BURGOS, LA UNION AUTHORIZING FOR THIS PURPOSE THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF AN ANIMAL POUND AND THE COLLECTION FEES FOR THE PROPER USE AND MAINTENANCE THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, stray animals are prevalent in public places within the Barangay Delles, Burgos, La Union;

WHEREAS, Sanitation and cleanliness of public places is greatly affected, it also contributes to the spread of diseases;

WHEREAS, it also recommended & supported by the BPOC to enact an ordinance regarding the matter;

WHEREAS, on motion of **SIMEON L. PING-AT** duly seconded be it be enacted by the Sangguniang Barangay of Delles.

SECTION 1: Short Title. This ordinance shall be as the Anti-Stray Ordinance of Barangay Delles, Burgos, La Union.

SECTION 2: Definition of Terms. As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall mean:

1. **ANIMAL OWNER**- refers to any person who has possession in terms of title or proprietorship or has actual control of an animal.
2. **DOMESTICATED ANIMAL**- refers to any animal species which are tamed and within the households of residents.
3. **ANIMAL POUND**- refers to a fixed enclosure complete with personnel and facilities for the temporary keeping of stray animals found within the municipality, to be hereinafter referred to as the "Barangay Pound".
4. **STRAY ANIMAL**-refers to any animal such as dog, cat, poultry, horse, goat, cow, carabao, wildlife, exotic and endangered species and the like at loose or elsewhere wandering in public places within the town without being accompanied by its owner.

SECTION 3: PHOIHIBITED ACTS

- A. No person shall be allow his/her animal to wander elsewhere in any public places within the Barangay without company of its owner
- B. It shall also unlawful to bring pets during the conduct of fiestas, public gatherings and programs and the like.

SECTION 4: ESTABLISHMENT OF ANIMAL POUND

1. There shall be established an animal pound in the Barangay to be officially named as Delles Animal Pound and to be referred to hereinafter as the Barangay Pound.
2. The Barangay Pound shall exclusively function as temporary lockdown for all seized stray animals.
3. The pound shall be situated at a definite site within the Barangay, with an environment not harmful to animals health and safety, this to be determined and designated for by the Punong Barangay pursuant to the town's subsisting zoning plan.
4. The Barangay pound shall be administered by all Barangay Officials and shall consist of facilities necessary to properly carry out the purpose and functions of an animal pound.
5. Funds necessary for the establishment and operation of the Barangay Pound shall be appropriate in the Barangay Annual Budget and/or any supplemental appropriation as the case may be, subject to the pertinent provision of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 5: AUTHORITY TO SEIZE AND IMPOUND. Authority is hereby granted to all Barangay Officials to seize and cause the impoundment of stray animal rights all the instance of its sighting.

SECTION 6: IMPOUNDMENT

- a. All stray animals shall be seized and impounded at the Barangay Pound until such time that the same are properly release to its lawful claimant.
- b. Impoundment and release of any such animal/s shall be pursuant to the following guidelines;
 - a) Impoundment period shall not exceed 3 days including Saturday and Sunday, excepts when impoundment for more than the prescribed period is necessary called for by medical reasons, in which case the animal owner of such impounded animal shall be duly advised.
 - b) All animals impounded pursuant to the preceding paragraph shall be fully entitled to proper custody, care, shelter and sustenance.
 - c) Animals which have died within impounding period shall be disposed of according to proper veterinary and health procedures. The Barangay Pound shall not take any responsibility whatsoever for any animal death, except when such death can be proven to have been due to neglect or deliberate cruelty on the part of the staff concerned.

SECTION 7: NOTICE OF IMPOUNDMENT

1. Within twelve (12) hours starting from the time an animal was committed for impoundment at the Barangay Pound, the personnel-in-charge shall locate and identity its animal owner, after which notice of impoundment shall forthwith be issued and served to such person.
2. When no animal owner shall have been located and identified with the impounded animal the same shall *ipso facto* be deemed abandoned, thus be properly disposed in accordance with the pertinent provision of Section 8 of this ordinance.
3. The personnel-in-charge of the Barangay Pound shall, from time to time, make a list of all impounded animals thereat, complete with corresponding identifiable description to include kind, breed. Color and other unique marking, if any there be, and post such list at designated public posting boards within the barangay.

SECTION 8: REDEMPTION

- a) An animal owner may, at any time after due receipt of the notice of impoundment issued pursuant to Section 6 (a) of this Ordinance but not no exceed 3 days after impounding, redeem an impounded animal right upon payment of the necessary fees and incidental charges.

- b) Whenever an animal owner, after due notice, deliberately refuses or neglects to redeem an impounded animal within the allowable period herein prescribed, she/he shall be made to pay a fine corresponding to **P200.00** for each day of default, or render community service equivalent to one(1) day for each day of default.

SECTION 9: DISPOSITION. The following rules shall govern the disposition of animals impounded at the Barangay Pound.

- a) Unclaimed animals at the Barangay Pound shall *ipso facto* be deemed abandoned, thus become eligible for adoption and may be released to any interested party after the lapse of three (3) days from the time of impoundment, provided: that such animal does not exhibit symptoms of any communicable disease.
- b) Whenever no interested party may opt to adopt, the Barangay Official shall have the right to cause such abandoned animal to be sold at a public auction;
- c) Abandoned animals exhibiting symptoms of any communicable disease shall forthwith be euthanized pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Administrative Order No. 21, Series of 1999, otherwise known as the Code of Conduct in the Euthanasia for Pets/Companion Animals and Slaughter of Animals for Food.
- d) No abandoned animal shall be euthanized without the approval of the Municipal Agriculture
- e) Abandoned animals eligible for adoption shall, before its release to any interested party, be administered with anti-rabies vaccine. Deliberate omission or neglect on the part of the personnel-in-charge at the Barangay Pound to perform his responsibility shall subject such person to Administrative and/or criminal sanctions.

SECTION 10: FEES

- a) The office of the Barangay Treasurer is hereby authorized to collect and issue corresponding receipt in the following amounts as legal fees in connection with the use of the Barangay Pound.
 - 1. **P100.00 –for everyday of impoundment or custody for small/large animals**
 - 2. **P200.00-fine for each day of default after the lapse of 3 days within which an animal owner is allowed to redeemed an impounded animal.**
- b) Fees and other proceeds collected and accumulated in connection with the enforcement of this Ordinance shall be held in trust by the Barangay LGU to be allocated only for the procurement of vaccines and other priority purchase of the Barangay Pound or other activities or programs relative thereto. Allocation and disbursement of said funds shall be done in accordance with the pertinent provisions of Chapter 2, Title V of RA 7160 or the Local Government Code 1991 and other applicable laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 11: PENALTY CLAUSE. Violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall subject the violator to the following fines as penalties.

- a. **Five Hundred Pesos (500) for first offense;**
- b. **Seven Hundred Pesos (700) for second offense;**
- c. **One Thousand Pesos (1,000) for third and subsequent violations.**

SECTION 12: REPEALING CLAUSE. The provision of previous local enactments, resolution, memorable circulars, and other issuance inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 13: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event that any provision of this Ordinance is found or decreed to be invalid or unconstitutional, all other provisions hereof no affected by such findings or decree shall remain to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 14: EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE: This Ordinance shall take effect accordance with law.
